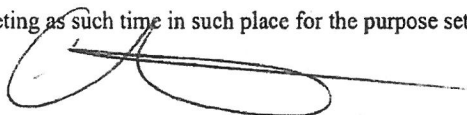

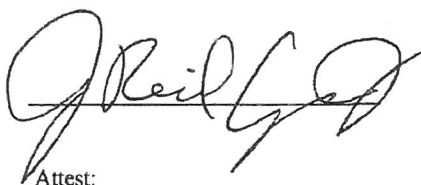
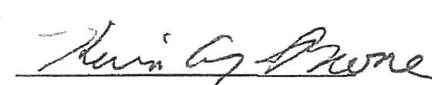

The City Council, City of Fairhope, met in Special-Called Session at 4:00 p.m., Fairhope Municipal Complex Council Chamber, 161 North Section Street, Fairhope, Alabama 36532, on Tuesday, 17 June 2025.

Present were Council President Jack Burrell, Councilmembers: Corey Martin, Jimmy Conyers, and Kevin Boone, Mayor Sherry Sullivan, City Attorney Marcus McDowell, and City Clerk Lisa A. Hanks. Councilmember Jay Robinson was absent.

There being a quorum present, Council President Burrell called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

The invocation was given by Councilmember Kevin Boone and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Council President Burrell stated that this meeting was called for the City Council to go into Executive Session.

Council President Burrell asked if there was any "New Business." No one brought up any new business.

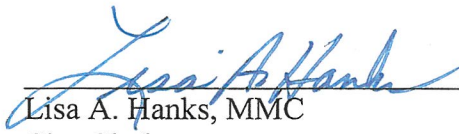
Councilmember Conyers moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Councilmember Martin, motion passed unanimously by voice vote.
